



Byorick Family Endowed Nursing Scholarship

This scholarship fund was established in 2017 by F. Joseph Byorick during his service as Chief Financial Officer of Penn Medicine Lancaster General Health. The fund provides annual need-based scholarship awards to students enrolled in any of the College's nursing programs.

Joe joined Lancaster General Hospital in 1972; since then, he managed all phases of hospital accounting, reimbursement, and finance, and was involved in the acquisitions and divestiture of related organizations, payer negotiations, and financial strategy development. He retired from his role as Chief Financial Officer in 2020. Joe is also a former member of the PA College of Health Sciences Board of Trustees. **He earned his master's degree in business administration from Shippensburg University and a bachelor's degree in business administration from Franklin & Marshall College.**

Joe's former wife, **Susan Book Byorick, is a 1977 Nursing Diploma graduate of PA College.** Upon graduation, Sue worked in labor and delivery at LGH while pursuing her BSN at Millersville University. Following a 15-year tenure with LGH, Sue continued her career as a Clinical Nurse Specialist at Drs May-Grant Associates from which she retired in 2015.
