

Anna A. Lombardo Endowed Scholarship

The Anna A. Lombardo Endowed Scholarship Fund was established in 2013 by nine nieces and nephews of Anna A. Lombardo in her memory. Anna A. Lombardo (1917-2012) graduated from St. Joseph Hospital School of Nursing in 1951. She valued education and obtained a **bachelor's degree** in Education from Millersville University in 1960.

Following graduation, she worked at St. Joseph's Hospital and Lancaster General Hospital. She also shared her love for nursing by passing on her knowledge and skills through teaching at the Willow Street Vocational-Technical School. After retiring from Lancaster General Hospital, she continued to give **back to the community by volunteering at St. Anne's Retirement Village in Columbia, PA.** When she passed away at age 94, she left her estate to her nieces and nephews.



Anna Lombardo impacted many people during her career in central Pennsylvania as a nurse **and loved working with student nurses. It is the donors' wish that her legacy will continue** through the impact this scholarship will have in the lives of the student recipients.
