A student may request to withdraw from PA College at any time. Prior to withdrawing, the student is strongly encouraged to contact their Academic Advisor or Program Director for advisement of withdrawal implications and assistance completing their [Leave of Absence or Withdrawal from the College Form](#) (available on the My PA College Portal).
